

## Directions to the ACRE office

### By rail

Nearest station: Kemble

From London, Paddington direct to Kemble or you may have to change at Swindon  
From the North or South West, change at Cheltenham.

The station at Kemble is 4.5 miles from Cirencester. Taxis are not always available at the station, so booking is advisable 15 minutes ahead of your arrival time. Approximate cost is £10.

### By road

From the M4 (London)

- Leave the motorway at junction 15, taking the A419, sign posted Swindon / Cirencester. Follow the A419 for approx 15 miles to Cirencester
- On approaching Cirencester at the first roundabout take the third exit, straight ahead, sign posted Cirencester / Stow / Burford
- Second roundabout, take the first exit, turning left into London Road, sign-posted Cirencester town centre
- At the first set of traffic lights, go straight ahead (Lewis Lane)
- At the second set of traffic lights, go straight ahead (Querns Lane)
- At the T-junction at the end of Querns Lane, turn left into Querns Hill
- Carry on up the hill, over the bridge where Querns Hill becomes Somerford Road
- Somerford Court is situated 200 metres after the bridge on the right-hand side and is a cream colour building with a clock on the front. Take the left-hand entrance into Somerford Court and drive to the car park at the back of the building where ACRE office is situated in Dean House.

From M5 (Bristol and the South West)

- Exit the M5 at junction 15. Take the M4, direction London
- At junction 17 leave the M4, taking the first exit left onto the A429, direction Cirencester, approx 18 miles

- At the T-junction turn right towards Cirencester passing the Royal Agricultural College on the left. At the first roundabout take the second exit, down the hill towards Cirencester
- At the next roundabout take the first exit left towards Cirencester town centre
- At the mini roundabout (Waitrose on the right, leisure centre on the left) turn left. Follow the one way system keeping in the right-hand lane as the road splits. Stay in the right-hand lane and follow the road round to the right, passing a car park on the right-hand corner, past the Marlborough Arms on your left
- Drive over a zebra crossing and the road splits, stay in the left hand lane. Waitrose will now be on your right-hand side and The Sidings veterinary clinic on your left
- At the mini roundabout continue straight ahead along Sheep Street into Querns Hill
- Carry on up the hill, over the bridge where Querns Hill becomes Somerford Road
- Somerford Court is situated 200 metres after the bridge on the right-hand side and is a cream colour building with a clock on the front. Take the left-hand entrance into Somerford Court and drive to the car park at the back of the building where the ACRE office is situated in Dean House.

#### From M5 West Midlands

- Leave the M5 at junction 11a taking the A417, direction Cirencester (approx 15 miles)
- Leave the A417 at the junction sign posted Cirencester / Stow / Lechlade
- At the first roundabout take the third exit, right, signposted Cirencester and at the second roundabout go straight ahead towards Cirencester, passing a BP garage on your left
- At the third roundabout take the second exit, straight ahead into London Road towards Cirencester town centre
- At the traffic lights continue straight ahead (Lewis Lane)
- At the next set of lights continue straight ahead (Querns Lane)
- At the T-junction at the end of Querns Lane, turn left into Querns Hill
- Carry on up the hill, over the bridge where Querns Hill becomes Somerford Road
- Somerford Court is situated 200 metres after the bridge on the right-hand side and is a cream colour building with a clock on the front. Take the left-hand entrance into Somerford Court and drive to the car park at the back of the building. The ACRE office is situated in Dean House at the back of the building.
